# LAKE HAVASU CITY

Topock Gorge, 30 miles north of Lake Havasu City on the Colorado River, with the Needle Mountains in the distance.

A young town (founded in 1963 and incorporated in 1978), Lake Havasu City was built on the spirit of possibility and innovation. It was in this spirit that town founder Robert P. McCulloch, Sr. purchased and relocated the town's showpiece, the London Bridge, from its original location in England to its new home in sunny Arizona.

Located on the shores of Lake Havasu, the city attracts 775,000 visitors a year with its calm waters, beautiful beaches and desert weather with more than 300 sunny days a year. Lake Havasu City is the major population center of Mohave County, with a population of 52,527 (2010). It's easily accessible by major highways and a short drive from Los Angeles, Phoenix and Las Vegas.

Lake Havasu City is a destination for boaters, water sport enthusiasts, hikers, nature lovers, car enthusiasts and history buffs. A range of accommodations and restaurants will ensure your stay is a comfortable one.

## Beaches & Swimming Facilities

### LAKE HAVASU STATE PARK

699 London Bridge Rd • (928) 855-2784

**Fees:** \$10 Mon–Thu, \$15 Fri–Sun & holidays, \$3 per person walk-in

**Hours:** 6:00am–10:00pm • **Leashed pets welcome**

*Right on the shores of Lake Havasu, the park offers panoramic views of the lake and mountains beyond. Picnic tables, grills and ramadas make this the perfect site to enjoy the city’s only white sand beaches. You can also hike along the Mohave Sunset Trail, a short but scenic 1.75 mile walk, as well as through the Arroyo-Camino Interpretive Garden, home to diverse species of plants and wildlife.*

### LONDON BRIDGE BEACH

**Fees:** Free • **Hours:** Daybreak–10:30pm • **Leashed pets welcome**

*Located along the famous Bridgewater Channel, London Bridge Beach features a community stage, fully enclosed dog park, and basketball and sand volleyball courts. A designated area is clearly marked for safe wading and swimming. There is also day mooring available along the channel on a first-come, first-served basis.*

### ROTARY PARK

**Fees:** Free • **Hours:** Daybreak–10:30pm • **No pets allowed**

*Rotary Park has it all — grassy fields, sand volleyball and bocce ball courts, playgrounds, a skate park, meandering walkways, shaded picnic ramadas, and a beach! The beach has a designated swim area that is clearly marked, so the kids can splash in safety.*

*The Nautical Beachfront Resort’s infinity-edge pool, “WET,” is the largest in Arizona. Enjoy a refreshing dip while sipping a cold beverage from the poolside bar. There is also an onsite water play area open seasonally.*

## HELPFUL HINTS

The bright Arizona sun, cloudless skies and dry air make for an enjoyable day relaxing and basking on the beach, but can also dehydrate and burn if you’re not careful. Make sure to bring plenty of water and sunscreen to the beach to ensure you enjoy your entire visit to Lake Havasu City!

Lake Havasu easily ranks as one of the best fishing lakes in the Southwest. Fishing is popular all year long. Anglers can haul in black (large & small-mouth) bass, striper, panfish and catfish. Bag limits are 10 striper, 6 bass, 25 catfish, and unlimited crappie/sunfish. Cast your line from free public fishing docks, boats or along the shore.

### HAVASU NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE, CATFISH PARADISE

Hwy 40 at Arizona Exit 1; follow the signs to Havasu NWR (30 miles north across from Topock, CA), Open 24 hrs.

### HAVASU SPRINGS

2586 Hwy 95, Parker; check in at front desk if gate is locked (23 miles south), Open 24 hrs.

### MESQUITE BAY

**Two docks at this location**  
London Bridge Rd, north of Industrial Blvd, Open 24 hrs.

### SITE SIX

591 Beachcomber Blvd (on the Island), Open 24 hrs.

## FISHING LICENSES

A valid Arizona fishing license and Colorado River stamp are required for anglers 14 years of age or older. Youth under the age of 14 and blind residents are exempt. Annual fishing licenses are \$23.50 for residents and \$70.25 for nonresidents; a Colorado River Stamp is \$3. (Daily licenses are \$16.25 for residents and \$17.25 for nonresidents.) A California fishing license is only required if you fish from the California shore. Licenses/stamps are available online at [az.gov/app/huntfish](http://az.gov/app/huntfish).

A state record-setting redear sunfish was caught on Lake Havasu on May 2, 2011 by local fisherman Robert Lawler (pictured at right). The catch also tied the world record for largest sunfish, which was set in 1998. In November 2013, a whopping 37-lb striper was also hauled out of the lake.

Want to try for a record-setting catch of your own? For information on the best bait, lures and times to fish for different species, see the tips below.

### LARGEMOUTH BASS

Fish for largemouth bass in the morning in areas that will have cooler water — near structures and submerged vegetation is ideal. Largemouth prefer lures to live bait and will bite on topwater lures, buzzbaits and spinner baits in the early morning, and jigs, crankbaits and swimbaits in the later morning.

### PANFISH

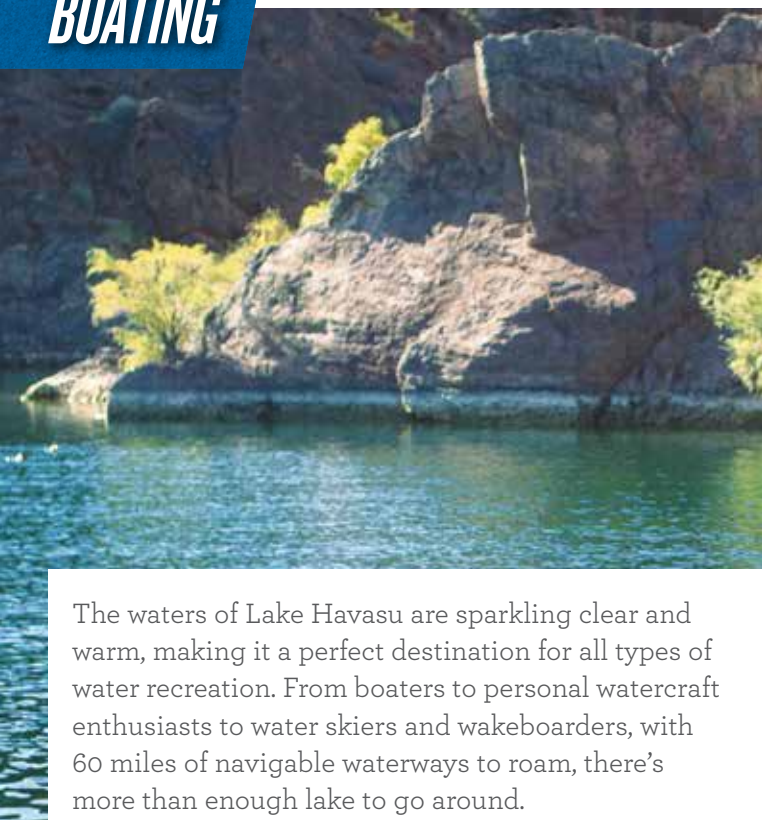
Any time is a good time to try for panfish, like redear sunfish. Panfish bite on mealworms, nightcrawlers and lures like crappie jigs or small trout spinning lures.

### SMALLMOUTH BASS

The best time to catch smallmouth bass, which are especially plentiful February–April, is early morning and late afternoon. Fish for smallmouth using lures such as topwater lures, lipless crankbaits and white crappie jigs.

### STRIPED BASS

Early morning and late afternoon are the best times for hooking a striper, which are plentiful August–October. Try anchovies, mackerel, squid, shad or bluegill. Lures also work well, such as topwater lures for morning or shad imitations and swimbaits in the late afternoon.



The waters of Lake Havasu are sparkling clear and warm, making it a perfect destination for all types of water recreation. From boaters to personal watercraft enthusiasts to water skiers and wakeboarders, with 60 miles of navigable waterways to roam, there's more than enough lake to go around.

Lake Havasu has a wealth of hidden coves and beaches that are perfect places to fish or relax for the day. You can also opt to explore the river with its canyons, cliffs and abundant wildlife. Water temperatures range from 75 to 85 degrees during much of the year, perfect for a quick dip (see the surface water temperature chart on page 38).

## Must-See Boating Attractions

### COPPER CANYON

This large cove surrounded by towering red rock cliffs is the perfect place to drop anchor and spend the day.

### BILL WILLIAMS RIVER NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE

A popular spot among kayakers, anglers, and nature lovers.

### TOPOCK GORGE

Head north upriver from Lake Havasu City through this majestic gorge to see towering red rock canyon walls, old steamboat routes and native wildlife.

**GPS: 34.39.14N/114.27.02W**

### PICTURE ROCK

About two miles from the southern entrance of Topock Gorge, this rock formation on the east side bears prehistoric petroglyphs carved into the stone face.

**GPS: 34.37.42N/114.26.36W**

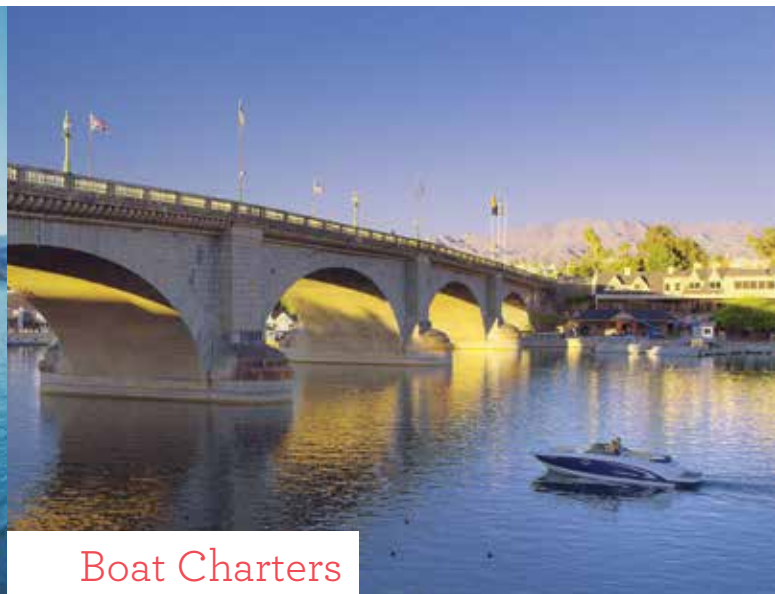
Boating on Lake Havasu also has a quieter side — have you tried kayaking, canoeing or standup paddleboarding (SUP) yet?

Site 6 Launch Ramp



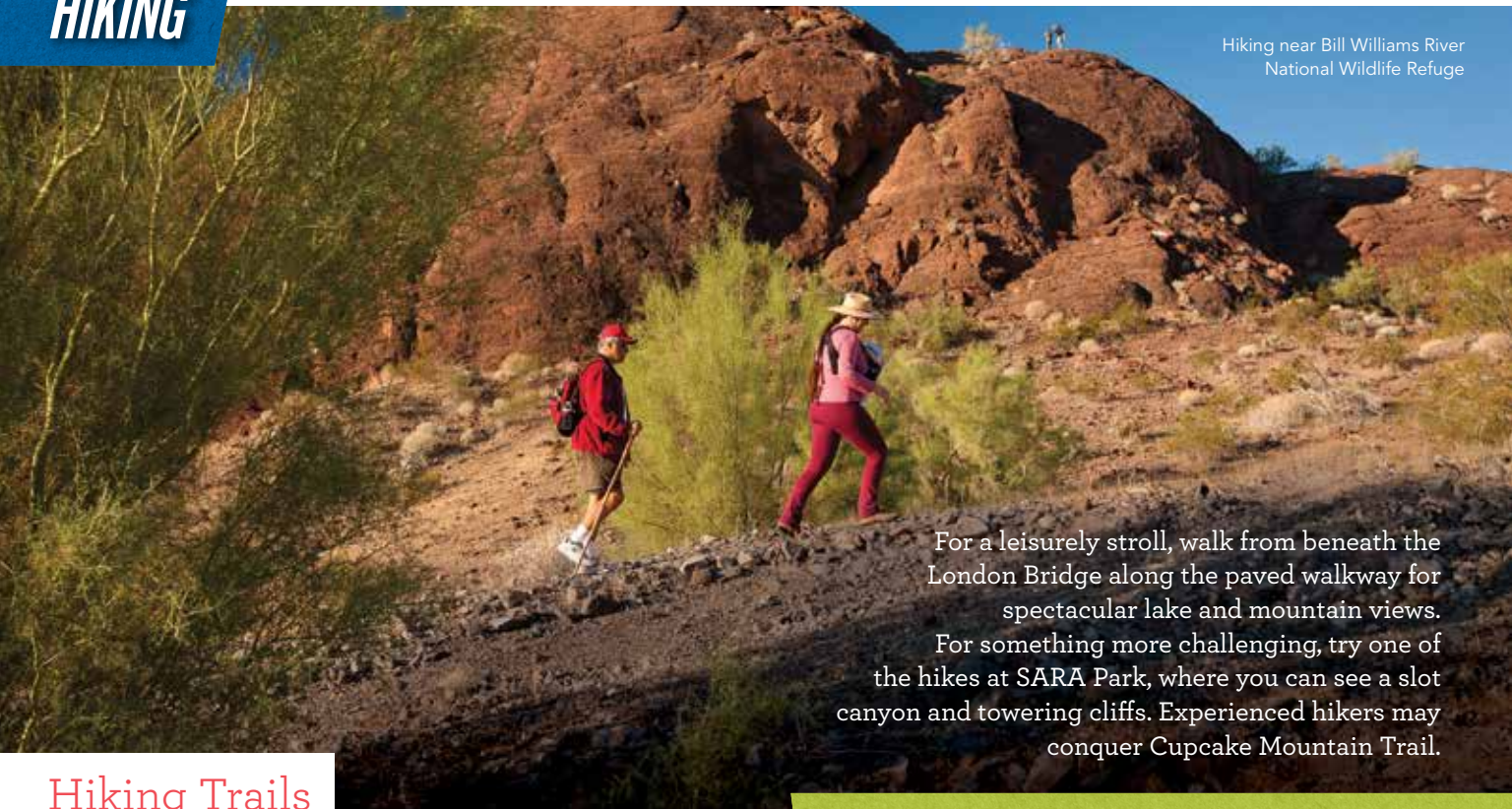

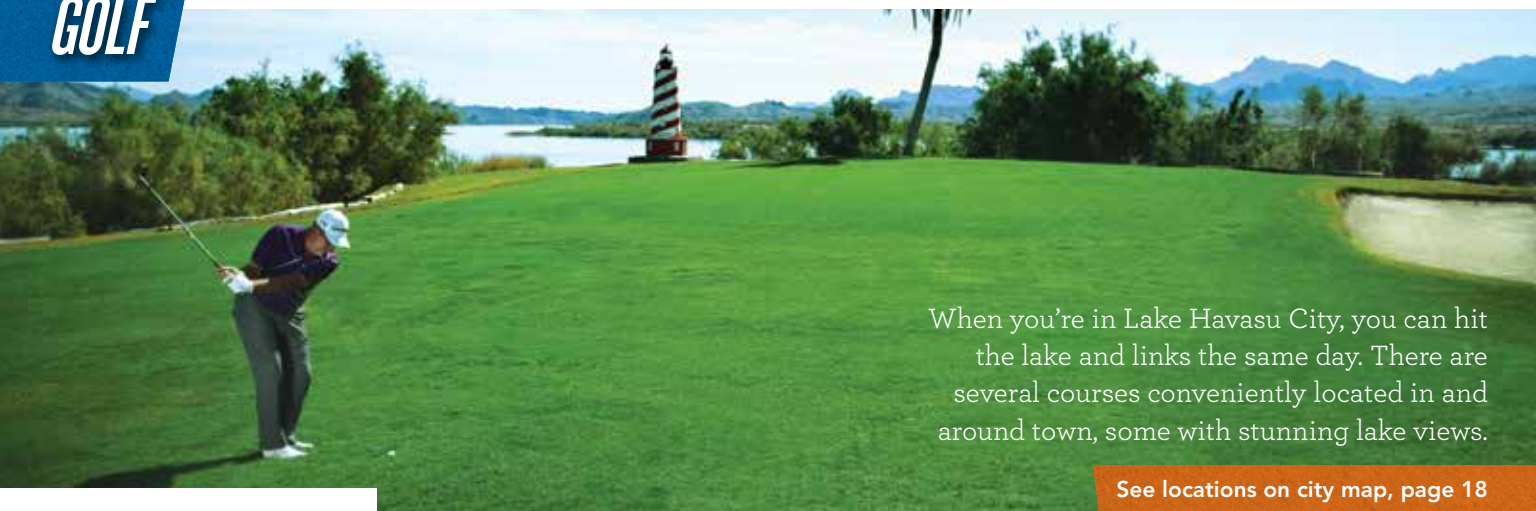

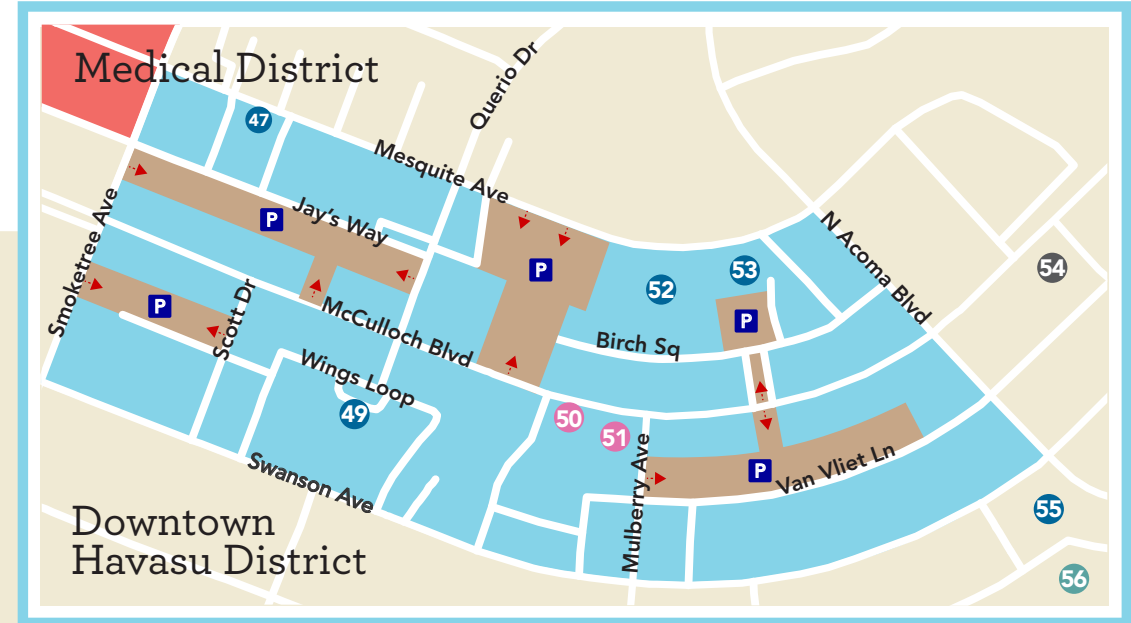

## Birdwatching

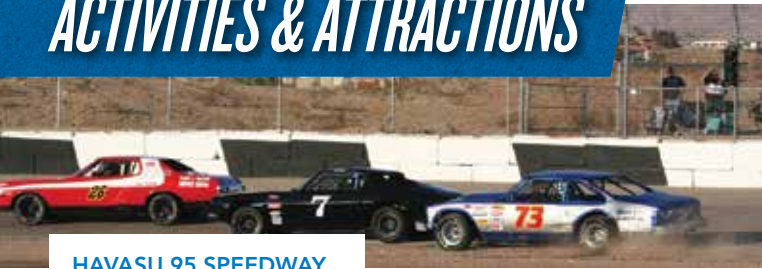
Numerous bird species are found in Lake Havasu City, especially around the shoreline and within the many coves of Lake Havasu and along the adjacent sections of the lower Colorado River. A rare sighting of the Lesser Black-Billed Gull (the third recorded sighting in Arizona) was made by a nature photographer kayaking in Thompson Bay in November, 2012.

Some of the species in the area include:

- Anna's Hummingbird
- Costa's Hummingbird
- Great Blue Heron
- Great Egret
- Great Horned Owl
- Western Grebe
- Vermillion Flycatcher

Of special note is the Bill Williams Wildlife Refuge, located 23 miles south of Lake Havasu City. Home to 366 species of birds, the refuge was designated as an Audubon Society Globally Significant Important Bird Area in 2011 following the spotting of a rare Nutting's Flycatcher. Since then, the Nutting's Flycatcher has remained in the area and mated.

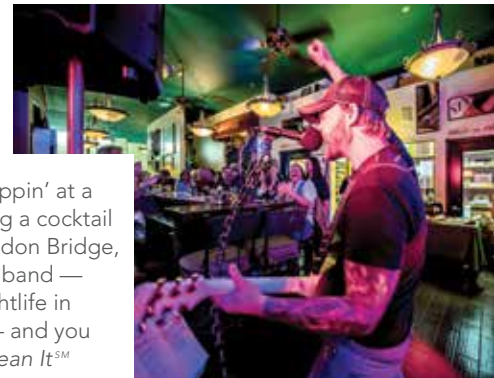

## London Bridge

The London Bridge is one of Arizona's biggest visitor attractions. It was designed in 1799 by Scottish engineer John Rennie and opened in 1831, spanning the River Thames in London, England.

By 1924, it was evident that the bridge was sinking, as it had not been designed to withstand the impact of 20th century automotive traffic. In 1967, the City of London placed the bridge up for sale.

On April 18, 1968, the winning bid went to Lake Havasu City founder Robert McCulloch for \$2,460,000. Each block was meticulously numbered before the bridge was disassembled. The blocks were then shipped overseas to California and trucked to Lake Havasu City, where the bridge was reconstructed and rededicated in a ceremony on October 10, 1971.

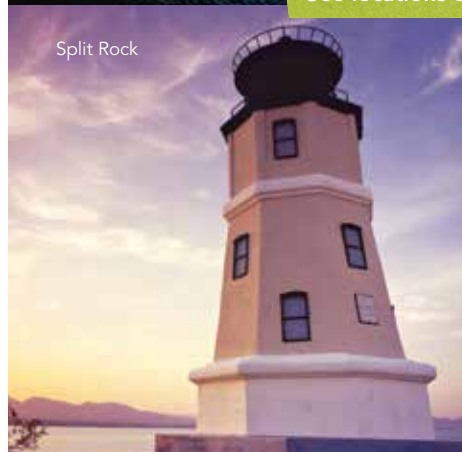

The bridge is rumored to be haunted! For years, visitors have sighted the figures of a British police bobby and a woman in black.

Kaboom! The vintage lamps on the London Bridge are made from the melted down cannons of Napoleon Bonaparte's army.

## Lake Havasu Lighthouses

Located over 200 miles away from the nearest ocean, Lake Havasu City is home to 24 lighthouses. Each lighthouse is an actual navigational beacon for boaters on Lake Havasu and meets all U.S. Coast Guard requirements. All but one lighthouse are 1/3 scale replicas of actual U.S. lighthouses.

A map of lighthouse locations is available at the Visitor Center. Take a self-guided tour of these miniature maritime marvels. 11 lighthouses are accessible by land; the rest may be seen from the lake. The lighthouses are erected and maintained by the Lake Havasu Lighthouse Club, a local nonprofit group.
